



2017 Growing Gardens' Cultiva Youth Project CSA Agreement

Members of the Cultiva Youth Project CSA will receive a weekly share of vegetables that will vary in size and weight depending on the time of the season. CSA members agree to support the Cultiva Youth Project by sharing in the inherent risks of agriculture (poor weather, drought, hail, crop failure, etc.) and the rewards (fresh, local vegetables, the bounty of a good season and supporting local youth).

I understand that when I join the Cultiva CSA, not only do I receive weekly shares of fresh, seasonal, organic produce, but the CSA fee helps pay youth salaries. With my support, the teens engage in meaningful work alongside a diverse group of peers, and I get to be part of the process. With the purchase of my share, I'll effectively "sponsor" a participant for the summer (participant salaries are roughly equivalent to the price of two shares).

I understand the CSA principle and agree that there is no guarantee on the exact amount or type of produce I will receive in my share. By participating in the CSA, I am supporting the Growers and Cultiva Youth Project participants as well as more equitable food distribution, and I am helping to create community through urban agriculture.

By becoming a member of the Cultiva CSA, I commit to picking up my share each week. I understand that there will be no special arrangements or schedule changes made for missed pick-ups. All produce that is not picked-up on the designated day is donated to a local nonprofit.

Refunds are not given for any reason.

I have read and fully understand the above. I understand this agreement shall not be modified orally.
